

Dear Parent/Carer

Your child has completed online GL assessments in English, Science and Mathematics earlier this term which concentrate on key content and skills.

To support them in closing any gaps in learning and to measure progress, they will have an opportunity to retake these assessments during January 2018.

These online assessments will take place within lesson time and will provide a GCSE Indicator Score (projecting their likely GCSE grade) and an SAS score which tells us a pupil's progress against national standards.

I'm sure that you will agree that it is vital that these assessments are taken seriously as, along with Teacher Assessments, decisions regarding sets and groupings will be informed by the outcomes of these assessments.

To support their progress, it is important that pupils work on their knowledge and understanding of key topics and practice key skills below in preparation for the GL Assessments.
