Dear Parents and Carers,


Over the last few days we have had a number of fire alarms. These have been set off deliberately by students. In each case we investigate and when we find the student responsible he or she is sanctioned in accordance with our behavior policy. While this deals with the particular student it doesn't alter the fact that all our students are losing valuable teaching and learning time.

I am writing this letter to inform you that from Monday 1st April 2019 should the fire alarm be set off deliberately again I will be extending the academy day on that day by 10 minutes until 1520. This will ensure that our students and your sons and daughters do not miss out on their learning. Anytime lost to the alarm will be caught up immediately after the academy day.

This morning Mr Kemp and I spoke to all of year 7 in assembly and next week we will speak to older year groups. We spoke about the dangers of fire in any building and the need to have a fire alarm system to ensure all students, staff and visitors are kept safe. It is imperative that the fire alarm system is not deliberately set off as this potentially threatens the safety of all of us.

I am grateful for your support with this in ensuring that we continue to provide your sons and daughters with their education.
